

Transcendentals – Submission Guidelines for Essays

Essays must be between 750 and 2000 words. Topics can range on whatever the writer chooses but should ultimately tie in with the issue's theme and the transcendentals (truth, beauty, goodness). We will not accept personal testimonies or pieces solely commenting on contemporary issues (there are other platforms for that; such as Convivium). They do not have to be explicitly related to the transcendentals but should at its core be reflective of them. Please leave space for paragraphs, use size 12 font, and use 1.15 spacing. Send using Microsoft doc. They do not have to be academic in nature but should not be overly informal either. In terms of format, please follow the Canadian Press Style Guide.
